Sub: Application dated 19.04.2017 of the President, Bharateeya Sanskriti Prabodhini, Gomantak Ayurveda Mahavidyalya & Research Centre, Shiroda, Goa to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa and (ii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana with 06 seats in each subjects from the academic session 2018-19 under Section 13A of the IMCC ACT and matter related to withdrawal of permission of a period not exceeding five year and converted to conditional permission to conduct UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats from the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC ACT , 1970 - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No.R.17011/18/2016 dated 02.09.2016 and CCIM's letter vide Ref.No.26-19/2017-College dated 05.02.2018 issued Letter of Intent to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa and (ii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana with 06 seats in each subjects to aforesaid college.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 31.05.2018 & 01.06.2018 to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training for conducting UG & PG courses as well as for issuing/not issuing LOP to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa and (ii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana with 06 seats in each subjects and also verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the Professor in Kayachikitsa Department, Yoga teacher,

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required number of clinical registrar, 01 Lab Technician and 01 Lab Assistant in Rasashastra Dept, Demo Room, web based computerized central registration system, Functional X-ray, ECG & USG, Animal House and Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff were not available as per RMS, 2016. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 28.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, PG Ayurveda regulation, 2016 and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs), it is found that College is not fulfilling the above mentioned Regulations and SOPs for permission granted for a period not exceeding 05 years (i.e. from the academic session 2015-16 to the academic session 2019-20) to the college for existing UG/PG course/s vide Ministry's letter No's. R.17011/18/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 02.09.2016.

4. It has been decided by the Central Government for *Withdrawal of permission for a period not exceeding five year (i.e. from the academic session 2016-17 to the academic session 2020-21)* granted to the college for *60 seats in UG (BAMS) course* vide Ministry's letter No's. R.17011/18/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 02.09.2016 and its conversion to conditional permission for the current academic year 2018-19 only and issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) to *Bharateeya Sanskriti Prabodhini, Gomantak Ayurveda Mahavidyalya & Research Centre, Shiroda, Goa* to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) *Kayachikitsa* and (ii) *Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana* with 06 seats in each subjects for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018:

- (i) Appointment of Clinical Registrar in the Hospital.
- (ii) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
- (iii) Functional ECG section in the Hospital.
- (iv) Animal House in the College Hospital.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG Courses; and
- (iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.


6. This permission to open new PG courses as mentioned above for the first admitted batch of 2018-19 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against the course appear for the first final examination of the said course and at that time, the college authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.

7. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers, as prescribed in the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the students in the above-mentioned open new PG courses is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

8. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

9. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
